Dear Delegate

Welcome to Objective Capital's Commonwealth Resources Investment Forum. We are going to be looking today at 3 mining companies operating in the Commonwealth member countries of Tanzania and Australia. Two countries on opposite sides of the world that are united by two things: membership of the Commonwealth of Nations and mining.

The Commonwealth member states cooperate within a framework of common values and goals. These include the promotion of democracy, human rights, good governance, the rule of law, individual liberty, egalitarianism, free trade, multilateralism and world peace. The Commonwealth is an intergovernmental organisation in which countries with diverse social, political and economic backgrounds are regarded as equal in status, but it is not a political union.

Australia's Julia Gillard is the current Chairperson of the Commonwealth. Western Australia is a traditional mining centre with the mining and petroleum industries accounting for almost 90 per cent of the State's income from exports. The region's mining revenue is also a significant contributor to the economy of the Commonwealth of Australia. Gold is one of the biggest revenue earners in the state of Western Australia as it is also in Tanzania.

Tanzania has a tradition in mining and was smelting steel 2000 years ago. The mining industry in Tanzania today contributes about 2.3 per cent of the GDP. It is one of the leading generators of foreign exchange earnings within the non-traditional export arena. In the government's Development Vision, by 2025 mining is projected to account for 10 per cent of Tanzania's economy.

Today we will hear from a gold miner in Australia, a gold explorer in Tanzania and a rare earth developer with properties in both.

We hope you will appreciate hearing about these companies in our new format forum over lunch. Enjoy.

Navigator Resources Limited (ASX:NAV) is engaged in the production of gold and exploration for precious and base metals in Western Australia. Its projects include the Leonora Gold Project and Bronzewing Gold Project, as well as three projects in the East Kimberley region, which embrace the 75%-owned Cummins Range Rare Earth Project and Eastman and Laura River Projects. The Leonora Gold Project is located 35 kilometers northeast of the mining town of Leonora, and approximately 250 kilometers north of Kalgoorlie, Western Australia. The Bronzewing Gold Project is located approximately 83 kilometers northeast of Leinster and 800 kilometers northeast of Perth. The Laura River project contains several types of mineralization.

David Hatch joined Navigator Resources as Managing Director in May 2010 and since that time has overseen the Company's transition towards mid-tier gold producer. David has an accomplished track record in the management, optimisation and development of mining assets. His career has included tenure as Managing Director, Kingsrose Mining Limited; Managing Director, Westonia Mines Limited (now Catalpa Resources); as Managing Director, Abosso Minerals Limited; managing the Damang gold mine in Ghana; and as General Manager of the Mt Muro gold-silver mine in Kalimantan.

Peak Resources Limited (ASX:PEK) operates in two segments: Tanzania and Australia. The recent focus has been on the Ngualla Rare Earth Project, which is centered on the Ngualla carbonatite in southern Tanzania, approximately 120 kilometers north-north-west of the regional center of Mbeya. The Company also has mineralization projects of niobium, tantalum and phosphate, located in the Ngualla carbonatite. The Company's Australia projects include Three Rivers Project (copper and gold) and Menzies Gold Project. In February 2012, the Company acquired 100% interest in Zari Exploration Ltd.

Richard Beazley is the Managing Director of Peak Resources. Richard's career has included developing mining operations in the ocean at Cockatoo Island, to open cut in one of the wettest mines in the world. Richard managed operations for Consolidated Minerals, St Barbara Limited, Aditya Birla, Henry Walker Eltin Contracting, Sons of Gwalia and Gunpowder Limited. Richard holds a BE in Mining from the University of New South Wales and an MBA in Technology Management from Deakin University.

Kibo Mining

Kibo Mining PLC (AIM:KIBO) was established in early 2008 to explore and develop mineral deposits in Tanzania, East Africa and is listed on AIM and the JSE. Kibo has access to one of the largest mineral right portfolios in Tanzania both in the established and gold prolific Lake Victoria Goldfields and in the newly emerging goldfields of eastern Tanzania between the towns of Morogoro, Dodoma and Handeni. These projects comprise a total area of just over 18,000 square kilometres and field exploration is underway.

Louis Coetzee has 25 years experience in business. In recent years he has concentrated on the exploration and mining area where he has founded, promoted and developed a number of junior mineral exploration companies based mainly on Tanzanian assets. Louis is currently a Director and Chief Operating Officer of the Mzuri Group which has coal projects in Tanzania and coal, oil and gas projects in Russia. He is also Chairman and acting CEO of Australian listed East African Resources limited which holds copper and uranium exploration projects in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Tanzania respectively.
